

Accommodation and transportation

Transportation from Kansai International Airport to downtown Osaka

There are several ways to come to downtown Osaka, but bus services are strongly recommended. Take a bus bound for Osaka Station which departs from the first floor of the airport. For further information, see the following site:

Click 11 (Osaka Station). This is your bus. If your hotel is Hotel New Hankyu, you will find the name of the hotel on the time schedule of the bus services.

Hotels: There are no hotels around the Uegahara Campus of Kwansei Gakuin University. Reasonably-priced hotels are found in downtown Osaka. Please find one around Umeda, downtown Osaka. Hotel New Hankyu is one of them.

Transportation from Umeda to Uegahara Campus:

If you come to Uegahara Campus of Kwansei Gakuin University (which is called “Kangaku” for short) from downtown Osaka, you use Hankyu Railways. You go to Umeda Station of HR and buy a 260 ticket. Take an express train and leave it at the second stop, Nishinomiya-Kitaguchi Station, after about a 13 minute ride. Change to a local train bound for Takarazuka and leave it at the second stop, Kotoen Station, after a less than a five minute ride. You take a bus to Kangaku and pay 210 yen when you leave it after about a five minute ride. The route to the campus and the campus map are available from the following sites:
